10. **AI/Coding** – Enhancing computational thinking and introducing students to artificial intelligence and programming concepts.

The selection process was conducted in **Two Cycles**, ensuring students experienced diverse skill sets. After completing the first cycle, students had the opportunity to explore a second Club, enriching their learning and broadening their interests.

TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMME: EMPOWERING EDUCATORS

To enhance teaching methodologies and professional growth, several **Teacher Training Workshops** were conducted, covering topics such as **NEP & Technology in the Classroom, Assessment Strategies, and Phonics**. Experienced resource persons were invited to lead these sessions, equipping teachers with innovative techniques to improve student engagement and learning outcomes. These workshops were highly **interactive and successful**, fostering continuous development and excellence in teaching at DPS Nagaon.

ENHANCING ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE THROUGH TARGETED SUPPORT

1. **Disha Classes** were introduced to support academically weaker students by helping them strengthen their conceptual understanding and improve their academic performance. This initiative received overwhelming appreciation from parents for its effectiveness. **The programme was continued** during the **Second Session (2025- 2026)** to ensure consistent academic support and progress among students.
2. **Remedial Classes** were implemented across all grades, providing personalised guidance and additional academic assistance to students of varied learning levels. This initiative was also successfully continued in the **Second Session 2025-2026**, significantly enhancing overall academic performance and contributing to commendable examination results.

ADMISSION REPORT for Session (2025-26) & (2026-27)

For the **Academic Session 2025–26**, DPS Nagaon received a positive response with a total of **223 registrations**. After a systematic screening and interaction process, **153 students were successfully admitted** across various grades. During the session, **4 withdrawals** were recorded due to personal reasons. The encouraging admission figures reflect the continued trust and confidence of parents in the school's commitment to academic excellence and holistic development of students.

As of **16th February 2026**, the Registration process for the upcoming session **2026-27** is already underway, with **110 Registrations** received and **59 confirmed Admissions** so far. The steady enrollment figures highlight the growing trust and confidence of parents in our institution.

COST DEDUCTION STRATEGIES IMPLEMENTED IN THE INAUGURAL YEAR

At **Delhi Public School Nagaon**, we have prioritized **Cost-Effective Management** to ensure **optimal resource utilization** without compromising on quality. In our **Inaugural year**, I introduced several measures to **cut down unnecessary expenses and promote financial efficiency**:

1. **Stationery Management:** To curb wastage, I ensured that only essential stationery items were procured and efficiently utilized. To maintain accountability, Registers were introduced, and for different Academic Stocks, **Manual Stock Registers** were maintained and closed at the end of every month, ensuring systematic tracking and responsible usage.
2. **Photocopy Paper Usage:** Photocopy papers were used with **utmost caution** under my strict supervision to **avoid overuse and wastage**. The **Administration Manager** was assigned to oversee this cost-deduction strategy.
3. **Utilization of Rough Papers:** Instead of using new sheets, **rough papers with available writing space** were repurposed in offices, significantly reducing the need for **new paper or paper pads**.
4. **Electricity Conservation:** To **preEvent electricity wastage**, a **penalty system** was introduced for **teachers and non-teaching staff**. This initiative has fostered a **habit of switching off electrical appliances** when not in use.
5. **Cost-Effective Event Management:** Under my leadership, **grand school Events** were organized with **minimal expenses**, ensuring **efficient budget utilization**. The **Administration Manager and Team Admin** played a key role in executing this **cost-efficient approach** successfully.

Through these **strategic measures**, DPS Nagaon has ensured **responsible financial management**, setting a **strong precedent** for the years ahead.
